

AIVRTTAC PURPOSE

Our purpose is to provide technical assistance (TA) to guide American Indian Vocational Rehabilitation Services Programs in achieving their goals. The provision of TA will result in:

- **A greater number of tribal members with disabilities** engaging in high-quality competitive integrated employment
- **Increased opportunities for tribal members with disabilities** to obtain economic self-sufficiency
- **Development of the capacity of AIVRS Programs** to enhance performance



AIVRTTAC TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

AIVRTTAC TA is tailored to meet the needs of each individual AIVRS Program through the provision of Universal, Targeted, and Intensive TA. Depending upon the needs of the program, some of the services that AIVRTTAC specialists may provide include:

- **Intensive, site specific TA** including onsite guidance and coaching, covering areas that are important to program growth
- **Support for the development of AIVRS Programs' policies and procedures**
- **Expertise in the development of culturally appropriate VR practices**
- **Assistance in the development of a memorandum of understanding** between an AIVRS Program and the State VR agency with a focus on establishing and enhancing this partnership
- **Consumer case file reviews to provide insights** into program evaluation
- **Online training modules** (located on the AIVRTTAC website) covering topics that are relevant to AIVRS program personnel
