WHAT IS A DISABILITY:

A “disability” can be physical, mental, learning, or emotional condition that constitutes or results in a substantial impediment to employment. The following are examples of some “disabilities”.

- Mental Health Diagnosis
- Hearing/Vision Loss
- Arthritis
- Cancer
- Chemical Dependency
- Learning Disability

WHO IS ELIGIBLE:

If you want to go to work and your answer is yes to the following statements, you may be eligible.

- Do you reside on or near the boundaries of the Colville Indian reservation?
- Are you an enrolled member of a federally recognized tribe?
- Do you have a physical or mental impairment that results in a substantial impediment to employment.

We will work with you to complete our intake process. Counseling and guidance services are provided. This process will document the steps necessary for you to attain your employment goals.

TYPES OF SERVICES PROVIDED:

A variety of services are provided to assist eligible participants to obtain, reduce barriers and retain a job. These types of services may include but not limited to:

- Assessments, Evaluations, & diagnostic services
- Vocational and Technical services & devices
- Job search skill building & retention services
- Transitional services

DETERMINING YOUR VOCATIONAL GOALS

- Once found eligible for services, your counselor will work with you to develop your vocational plan.
- If you have job goals in mind, your counselor will help you explore their feasibility.
- If you do not have a clear career/employment direction, your counselor may have participate in a vocational/career assessment to establish your goals.
